



## Prayer Pendant Workshop Materials List

The pendants you will make will be very personal to you or the person who will receive it. Come with a prayer, mantra, short poem or other words of inspiration for the messages that will be sealed inside your pendants. Keep in mind that the piece of paper will be no bigger than the size of a business card.

Pendants will be crafted out of copper and PVC tubing and finished with small beads. The PVC can be carved and recesses filled with shoe polish to create your own pattern. Messages are sealed inside the tube with glue and then are coated in laquer.

Tools and materials are included; however, if you have any of these items, please bring them.

- jeweler's files
- Dremel or other rotary tool with bur engraver for carving into PVC – you may prefer using a larger bur engraver to create a stronger look.
- beads, head pins for embellishment
- jewelry making pliers, especially round nose
- cord or ribbon for stringing
- finishing components such as jump rings, toggles, etc.
